Following his appointment in my clinic this patient underwent further MR brain imaging (NHNN, February 2013).

The scan has been reported as follows:

"There are several small supratentorial foci of periventricular and subcortical white matter T2-hyperintensities, which are nonspecific. They are not excessive. There is no associated restricted diffusion. No space occupying lesion. No intracranial haemorrhage. No evolving infarct".

Impression and recommendations

I am reassured that there has not been significant deterioration in the radiological appearances, and that there is no acute lesion to account for his symptoms.
