Dear Mr Jones,

Can I firstly confirm receipt of the two items that you submitted with your accompanying letter, dated 26 January 2012.  
These are

1. 48 page personal medical and family case history entitled:

I have now had the opportunity to review both these items and have also visited the web site that you refer to in your correspondence.

You state that in 2003, following an earlier submission, you received a reply from Staffordshire Police stating that due to the lack of any prima facie evidence there would be no pursuant investigation. You have now supplied further information, namely Item 2, however having carefully examined the detailed information I have also come to the conclusion that there is insufficient evidence that would warrant the initiation of an investigation by Staffordshire Police.

I do however note that you remain concerned about ongoing threats to your safety and I would strongly advise that these matters are dealt with by your local Force.
