Dear Mr Jones

I am writing in connection with the complaint against police that you made on 21 December 2012.

This letter is to explain to you that I intend to formally apply to the Independent Police Complaints Commission for permission to take my investigations no further (disapplication).

The reason for this application is because the complaint is:

Out of Time: More than 12 months have elapsed between the incident, or the latest incident, giving rise to the complaint and the making of the complaint and either that no good reason for the delay has been shown or that injustice would be likely to be caused by the delay.

Repetitious: The complaint has been made previously and is therefore repetitious (PC/5697/12).

The events you are complaining about occurred in December 2010. You state that the reason for your delaying complaining was your subject access request.

I note you first contacted the Metropolitan Police regarding a request for information on 11/6/12.

You complained about the incident of 12th December previously. You were sent an outcome letter, which you appealed. The IPCC didn't uphold your appeal.

If you disagree with my decision, you have the right to tell me why you believe your complaint should not be disappplied. Your reasons will be taken into account before any final decision is made.

You must contact me with your reasons within 28 days of the day following the date of this letter. The 28th day is 12th February 2013. Information received after this date will not be considered.
