Dear Mr Jones

I am writing in connection with the application by PS Andrew Marshall on 12/2/12 for permission to take their investigations no further (disapplication).

I have seen the letter you sent to us with your reasons why we shouldn't Dis – Apply your complaint.

This letter is to explain to you that I have granted the request for disapplication on the following grounds:

Out of Time: More than 12 months have elapsed between the incident, or the latest incident, giving rise to the complaint and the making of the complaint and either that no good reason for the delay has been shown or that injustice would be likely to be caused by the delay.

Repetitious: The complaint has been made previously and is therefore repetitious (PC/5697refers).

You have the right of appeal in relation to this decision to the Appeals Unit of the Directorate of Professional Standards. There is no right of appeal to the IPCC. You have 28 days within which to make your appeal. The 28th day is 12th March 2013. ***Appeals received after 28 days may not be allowed unless there are exceptional circumstances.***
