### **Text**

#### **11/09/2015, 18:05, MRI Whole Spine**

Vertebral alignment is preserved and the cord is normal .

There is mild uncovertebral degenerative change in the mid cervical region which is associated with modest narrowing of the left C6 and right C7 neural foramina. The right C7 foramen appears the most significantly affected.

The remainder of the neural foramina appear intact.

The thoracic and lumbar regions show no compressive abnormality. There is some minor lumbar facet degeneration .
